Several years ago, Smith C. Banks initiated a Cenotaph service for Chesley Alderman at the Alderman family cemetery outside Statesboro, GA on May 7, 2005. Chesley was mentioned in our newsletter at that time to recognize him as a recipient of the Confederate Roll of Honor by the Confederate Congress.

There was never a formal medal issued to recognize these individuals due to the short life of the CSA. The Sons of Confederate Veterans developed a medal and has made it available to the families of these soldiers if they desire to recognize them. They require the family to coordinate with a museum to formally display the citation and medal before it is issued.

Smith and this editor talked a great deal prior to his passing several years ago but the acquisition of the medal never took place. In October, 2023, your editor requested Chesley's medal, had it framed, and it is now on display in the new National Confederate Museum in Columbia, TN. https://theconfederatemuseum.com

Your editor tried to get a museum in the Statesboro, GA area to display it but none would respond to my request. If you are ever in Columbia, TN stop by the museum and see his award proudly hanging in the research library. On the back of the frame, I placed a small engraved plate acknowledging the Alderman Historical Association.

Chesley was the son Thomas Alderman and Polly Ann Parish. He died on July 17, 1863 as a result of injuries during the Battle of Gettysburg.
